# 2020 BURGUNDY

## Intense whites - Opulent reds

2020 is yet another excellent vintage in Burgundy. The fourth hot, dry summer in a row produced full-bodied, rich and concentrated wines not dissimilar to those made in 2019.

The growing season started early with above average temperatures in both March and April. Bud break was 2 weeks before normal and the good weather continued into May ensuring an early and satisfactory flowering.

The summer was generally hot and dry with periods of extreme heat. Fortunately, there were occasional moments of rainfall, but not everywhere, and some vines on drier soils suffered from water stress. Despite the successful flowering, the general lack of rain ensured that the berries remained small with thick skins and little juice; the prospect of the bumper harvest that had been anticipated at the time of flowering was never fully realised.

The harvest began as early as mid-August. For many domaines, it was only the fourth time that they had started in August (previous 'summer vintages' were in 2003, 2017 & 2018).


Of the top Côte d'Or white wine producers, Alain Chavy was the earliest, starting on 18th August and finishing on 25th. By the end of the month, nearly all of Meursault and Puligny had been picked, the red wine harvest in the Côte de Nuits was in full swing and even Chablis, 120 km to the north, had made a start.

The resulting wines are rich, dense and concentrated. Prompt and speedy picking avoided the obvious pitfalls of over-ripe flavours, high alcohol and low acidity and the best examples are beautiful, complete wines which combine fully ripe fruit with high quality tannins and/or good acidity.

The whites are consistently fine from Chablis in the north to Mâcon in the south. The heat and lack of rain concentrated both sugar levels and acidity giving wines that are some of the most intensely flavoured whites that I have ever tasted. The alcohol levels tend to be 0.5% lower than in 2019 with greater freshness and minerality.

The reds are similarly well-endowed. It was easy to extract colour and flavour and the 2020s are dense and well-structured. The top vineyards have unsurprisingly produced magnificent wines but the vintage is particularly successful in appellations which habitually produce leaner, more austere wines such as Mercurey, Santenay, Monthelie, Savigny and Pernand-Vergelesses.

The only fly in the ointment is the small 2021 harvest that is pushing prices up. Lack of supply and huge, worldwide demand is inevitably having an effect and there are, unfortunately, more price increases in the pipeline. My advice is to buy sooner rather than later.

# Samuel Billaud

Samuel continues to make many of the most exciting wines coming out of Chablis today, equal in quality to those of Jean-Marie and Bernard Raveneau but at a fraction of the price.

His 2020s are a great range. Samuel decided to pick early, from 28th August to 6th September, and to age all his wines for at least ten months on the fine lees in order to achieve a winning combination of ripe, appley fruit on the nose, fresh, succulent texture on the palate and fine minerality and salinity on the finish. Samuel likens his 2020s to his 2017s - high praise indeed as the 2017s are currently developing into spectacularly fine wines.

A fatter, rounder style of Chablis with impressive depth and length on the finish. Drink 2022-2027.</i>

<i>Butteaux is an enclave within premier cru Montmains and Samuel vinifies it separately due to its distinctive, full-bodied yet mineral character. Fermented and aged for twelve months in 450 litre casks this is a great success; rich and powerful whilst retaining a fine, mineral streak. Drink 2022-2028.</i>

# Domaine Séguinot-Bordet

Jean-François Bordet runs this splendid, hugely successful, family estate that can trace its roots in the village of Maligny back to 1590. The domaine now extends to over 20 hectares on the right bank of the Serein where the high proportion of kimmeridgian limestone gives the wines additional minerality and intensity.

All the wines are vinified in stainless steel vats in the modern winery that Jean-François built for the 2014 harvest. His 2020s are some of his best ever, combining beautiful, ripe fruit and crisp, fresh acidity.

# Domaine Roy

The Roy family have been vigneron in the village of Fontenay, just to the north of Chablis, for over 200 years. Today Claude Roy, together with his children David and Karine, farm 18 hectares of vines on the right bank of the River Serein. Where they are one of the largest owners of the grands crus including a magnificent 3.5 hectare plot in Bougros.

In 2020, Claude picked early, from 29th August to 5th September. Fermented and aged in stainless steel vats in order to preserve the maximum of fruit, this is a magnificent range of crisp, elegant, pure, unoaked Chablis.

This is an exciting new property run by the husband and wife team of Vincent and Stéphanie Michelet. Stéphanie is the daughter of Jean-Claude Courtault, head of one of the oldest vine-growing families in Chablis.

The cellar and the majority of the 29 hectares of vines are in the village of Lignorelles but they also own land in the neighbouring villages and have plots in some of the finest premiers and grands crus. The wines are fermented and aged in stainless steel vats to preserve the maximum of fruit. The 2020s are a superb range of crisp, mineral wines.

# Domaine Vincent Latour

Vincent has just finished constructing a new cellar in the centre of Meursault giving him much-needed additional space. It allows him to house his interesting mix of oak casks; as well as the more usual 228 and 600 litre barrels, Vincent has a range of 2,500 litre oak foudres which were made especially for him by the tonnellerie Rousseau in Gevrey-Chambertin. These larger casks allow the wines to retain the maximum of freshness and vitality, a hallmark of the domaine. In 2020, Vincent harvested between 29th August and 6th September, producing a superb range of intensely-flavoured, concentrated wines.

## Domaine Yves Boyer-Martenot

Vincent Boyer has taken over from his father Yves and made some important changes. All the wines are fermented and aged for 12 months in oak barrels as before but now the wines spend a second winter either in small (900-1800 litre) egg-shaped, cement vats or 900 litre oak *foudres* purchased from *tonnellerie* Vicard.

The wines have a longer but slower *élevage* with less oxygen during the second winter which allows the wine to mature gently at low temperature and reduces the need for fining and filtration.

# Domaine Michel Bouzereau et Fils

Jean-Baptiste harvested earlier in 2020 than ever before, from 20th to 29th August. His 2020s are rich, intensely-flavoured wines that combine vibrant, honeyed fruit with crisp acidity. All the wines are barrel-fermented and aged for 12-18 months in cask. Between 15% and 25% of the barrels are renewed each year.

2020 sees the return to production of his fine Limozin vineyard which was replanted after the 2016 frost. Despite the youth of the vines, Jean-Baptiste has fashioned a delicious, forward, vividly fruity wine.

## Domaine Alain Chavy

Alain Chavy has been joined by his son Corentin at this splendid Puligny domaine, created in 2003 when Alain and his brother Jean-Louis went their separate ways.

Alain believes in harvesting early in order to retain as much freshness and acidity as possible. 2020 was his earliest ever vintage, starting on the 18th August and finishing on the 25th August. All his wines are fermented and aged for 12 months in a mixture of 228 litre and 400 litre barrels from *tonnelleries* Damy and Chassin followed by a second winter in stainless steel vats. This is a magnificent range of intense, taught, mineral wines.



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

# Domaine Florent Rouve

The harvest is 7 to 10 days later in the cooler, higher altitude Jura enabling Florent to pick both sets of vineyards consecutively. His Burgundy wines are rich yet fresh, all fermented and aged in barrel for 12-18 months in his cellars in Davayé. The Jura wines are crisper and leaner with less alcohol and higher acidity and are rapidly gaining a fine reputation for their freshness and minerality.



Brothers Nicolas and David Rossignol were one of the first to convert their family estate to biodynamic viticulture in 2004, since when they have consistently produced some of the most elegant wines of Gevrey with impressive purity of fruit and carefully extracted tannins.

The 2020s were fermented with 50%-60% whole bunches, a practice started in 2005, and extracted gently with no pigeage and only occasional remontage and délestage.
